




# During your trip to Costa Rica you will visit the following destinations:

San Jose City – Tortuguero Natioan Park – Arenal Volcano – Venado Caverns & Rio Celeste.

Your rout would be:



#### Arrival transfer, short drive of about 10 minutes to Hotel Herradura,

Overnight Standard room.



#### **Includes:**

Airport arrival transfer + overnight standard room with taxes and breakfast at Herradura Hotel.















Out early morning by deluxe bus to the Caribbean flat lands, across the Braulio Carrillo National Park and visit a **Banana** Plantation before boarding a small boat to navigate the Tortuguero Canals. On time for lunch at Pachira Lodge. Afternoon nature hike by the Tropical Rain Forest. Dinner and overnight at Pachira Lodge.





#### What to Bring:

What should I bring? What can I leave home? Am I really going to need this? This may be some of the questions every tourist asks himself while packing.
